

HHHi all,

First and foremost: this is a Halloween hash so don't forget to bring a costume for the Saturday night party! Spooky or gruesome, funny or bad taste, the choice is yours. The only bad costume is no costume! Prizes for the best and worst will be awarded!

And now a few other things you might need to know:

What should I bring?

Bedding: the venue provides a mattress and a scratchy wool blanket. Mismanagement recommends bringing either a sleeping bag or duvet/comforter with a sheet and a pillow or pillow case you can stuff things into to make a pillow (clothes, shoes, leafy plants, dirt, rodents, small Hashers, etc.).

Costume: a costume for Saturday's BerZuBa Halloween Party. There's no theme for Friday night but feel free to dress up anyway if you'd like. Over-achieving will be appropriately rewarded in the circle.

Drinking Vessel: bring something you feel comfortable drinking from and that you'll remember what it looks like. A limited supply of plastic cups will be available.

Other things to bring: A flashlight (torch), a towel, ear plugs, a *lanyard*, pain relievers (for your hangovers), *house shoes* to wear indoors!

Saturday's party includes the Exorcise Your Spirits idea so bring a bottle to share if you want and any special mixer. Normal mixers will be provided

Getting to the venue, the Pfadiheim Rothburg:

By car:

Plug the following into your GPS:
Pfadiheim Rothburg
Steinrain 9
4663 Aarburg

Or the following coordinates: 47°19'22.8"N 7°54'15.6"E

Note: There is plenty of parking at the venue but please don't use the spots which have a reservation sign with a license number on it.
DO NOT PARK DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF THE VENUE – this is reserved for the cars which will be used during the weekend for beer and food hauling as well as emergency shopping!

By train:

Take whatever train which gets you to the city of Aarburg-Oftringen. The walk to the venue is only about 10 minutes and will be marked but to help, make sure you exit the station on the (south)west side. On the map, the venue is called Pfadfinderheim – it is **NOT** the Jugendheim or Villa Jugend! Also, you can only get to the venue via Steinrain street from Bahnhofstrasse. Trying to exit the station from the (north)east side and get to the venue from there, despite appearing to be possible on the map, is blocked by private property with nasty signs about trespassing. As the houses there are our closest civilian neighbours, we'd rather not piss them off before we even get started.
